

# Horse Toilet Paper Roll Craft

I've included two different template choices (for no particular reason other than that I was having fun drawing!)

## Materials:

toilet paper roll,  
a printer,  
something to colour with,  
scissors,  
glue,  
paper

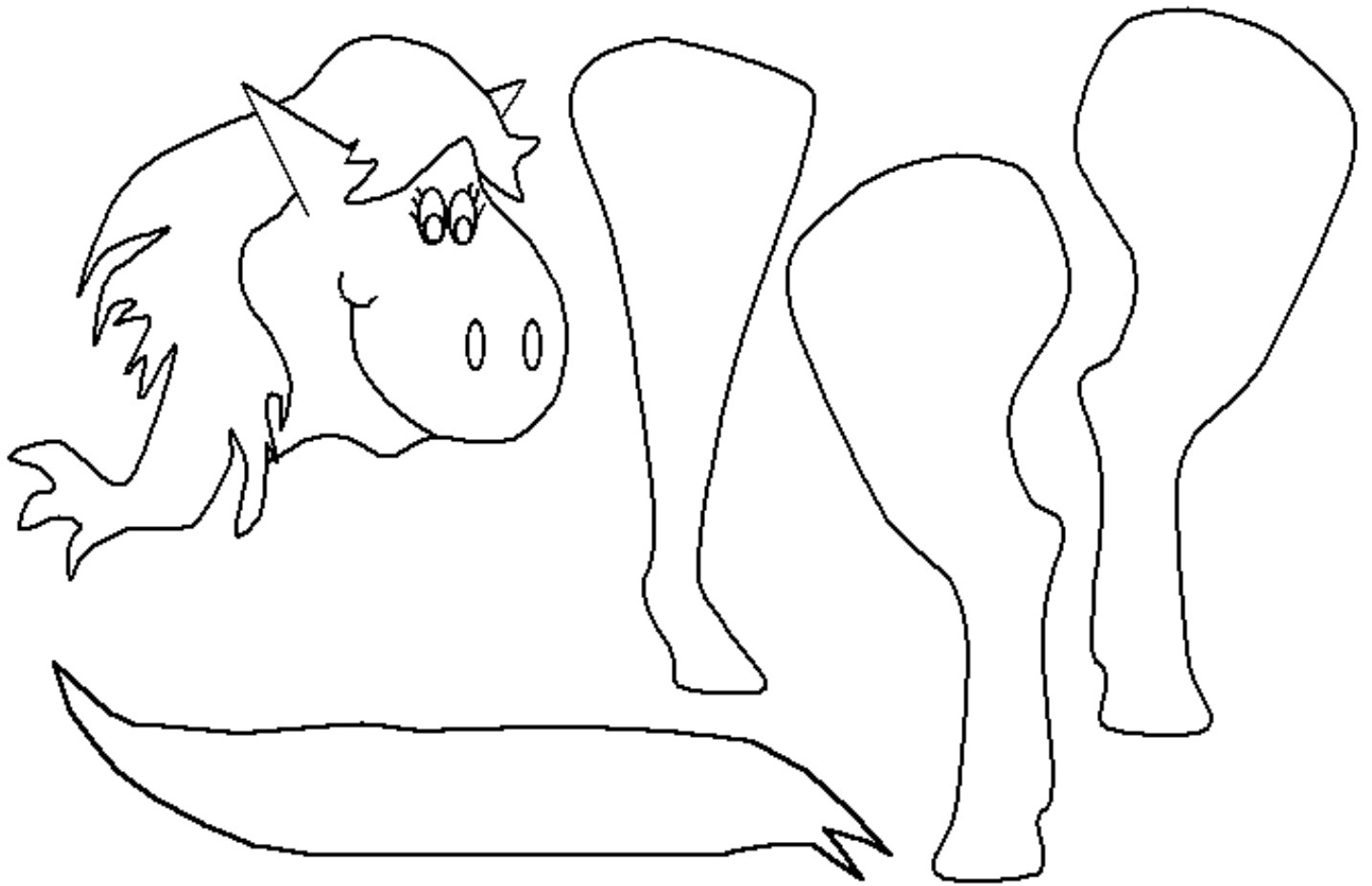
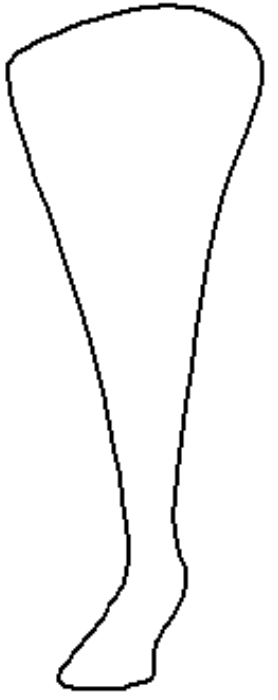
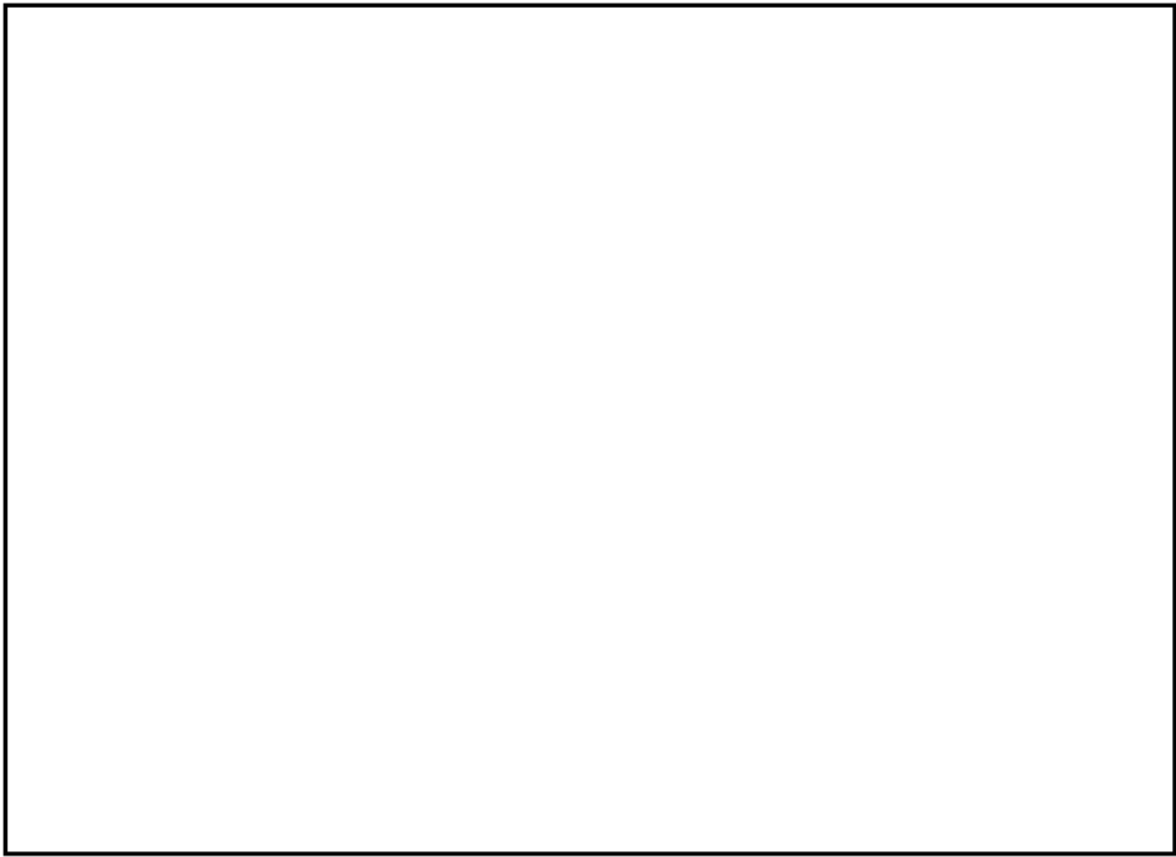


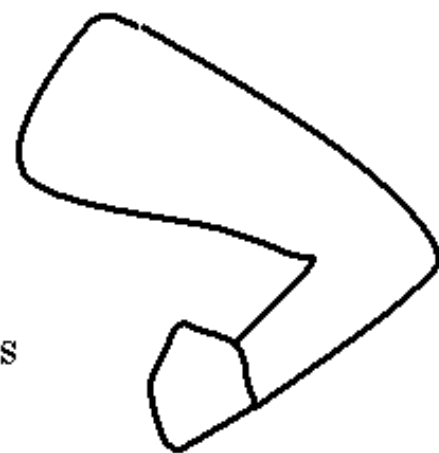
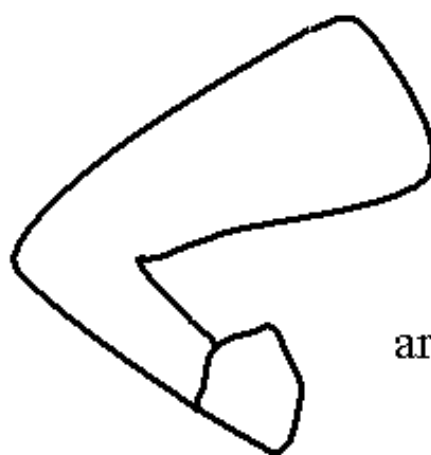
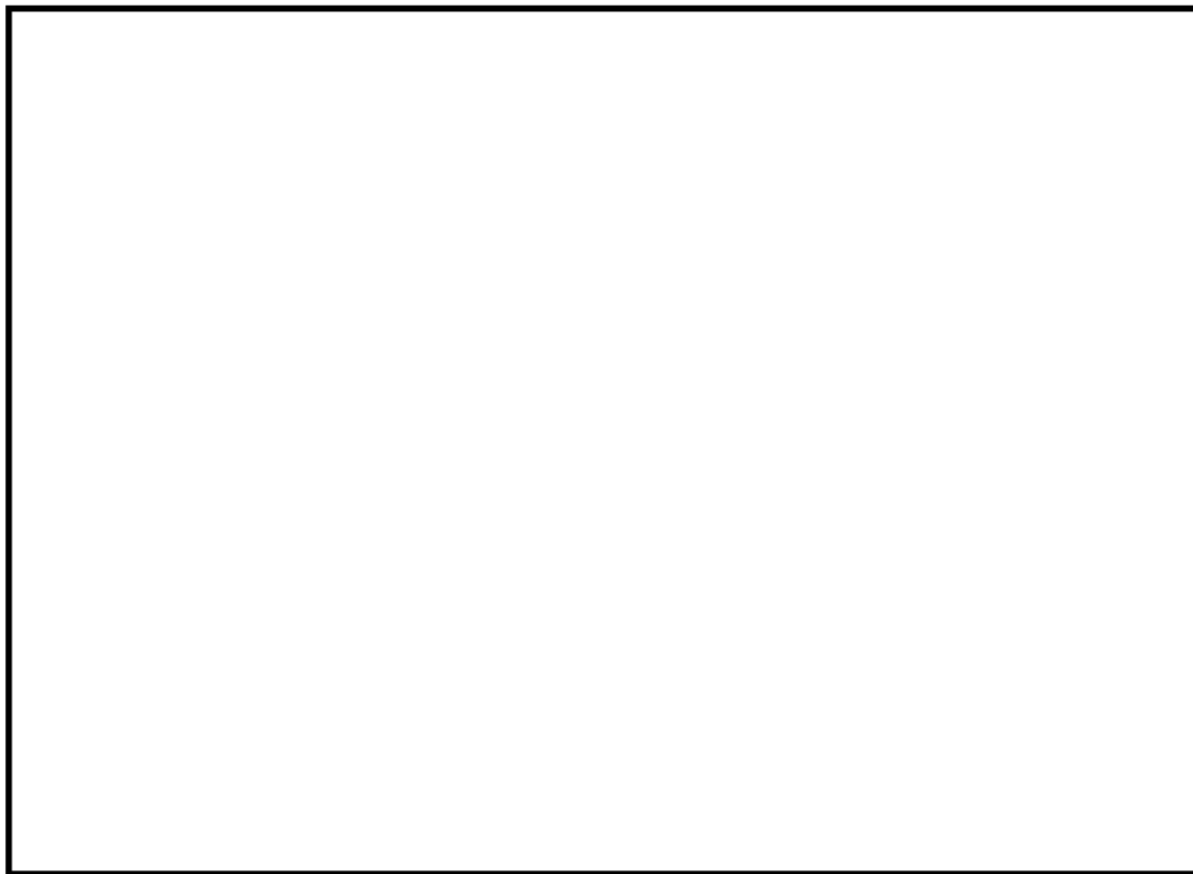
## Directions:

- Print out the template of choice.
- Colour (where appropriate) and cut out the template pieces.
- Glue the large rectangular piece on first to cover the tube. Toilet paper rolls come in different sizes, so if you find the rectangle is a bit too big, just trim it down. If you find it's a bit too small, just cut out another small piece to fill in the gap.
- Glue on the head and "arms"
- Fold the tabs on the feet and the tail and glue them onto to the tp roll to give it a 3 dimensional effect
- We typically make the crafts as if they're sitting up on their haunches as it's easier to construct them. (I think the horse looks cute this way)

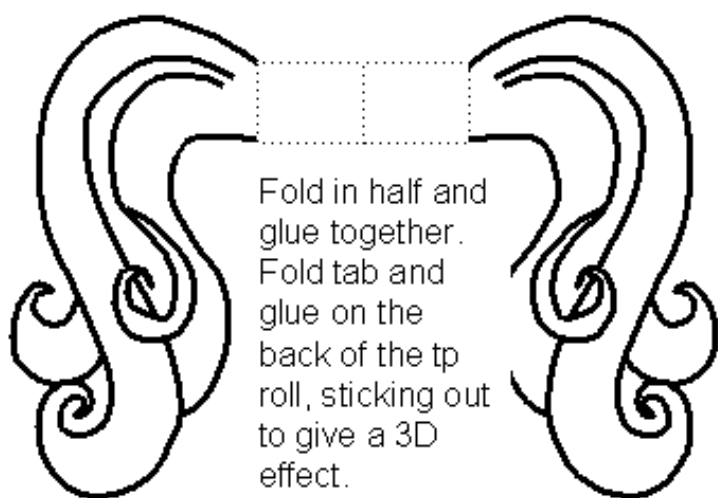
## Templates:

- Set page margins to zero if you have trouble fitting the template on one page (FILE, PAGE SETUP or FILE, PRINTER SETUP in most browsers).

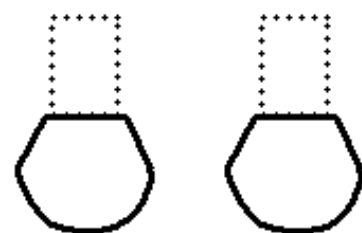




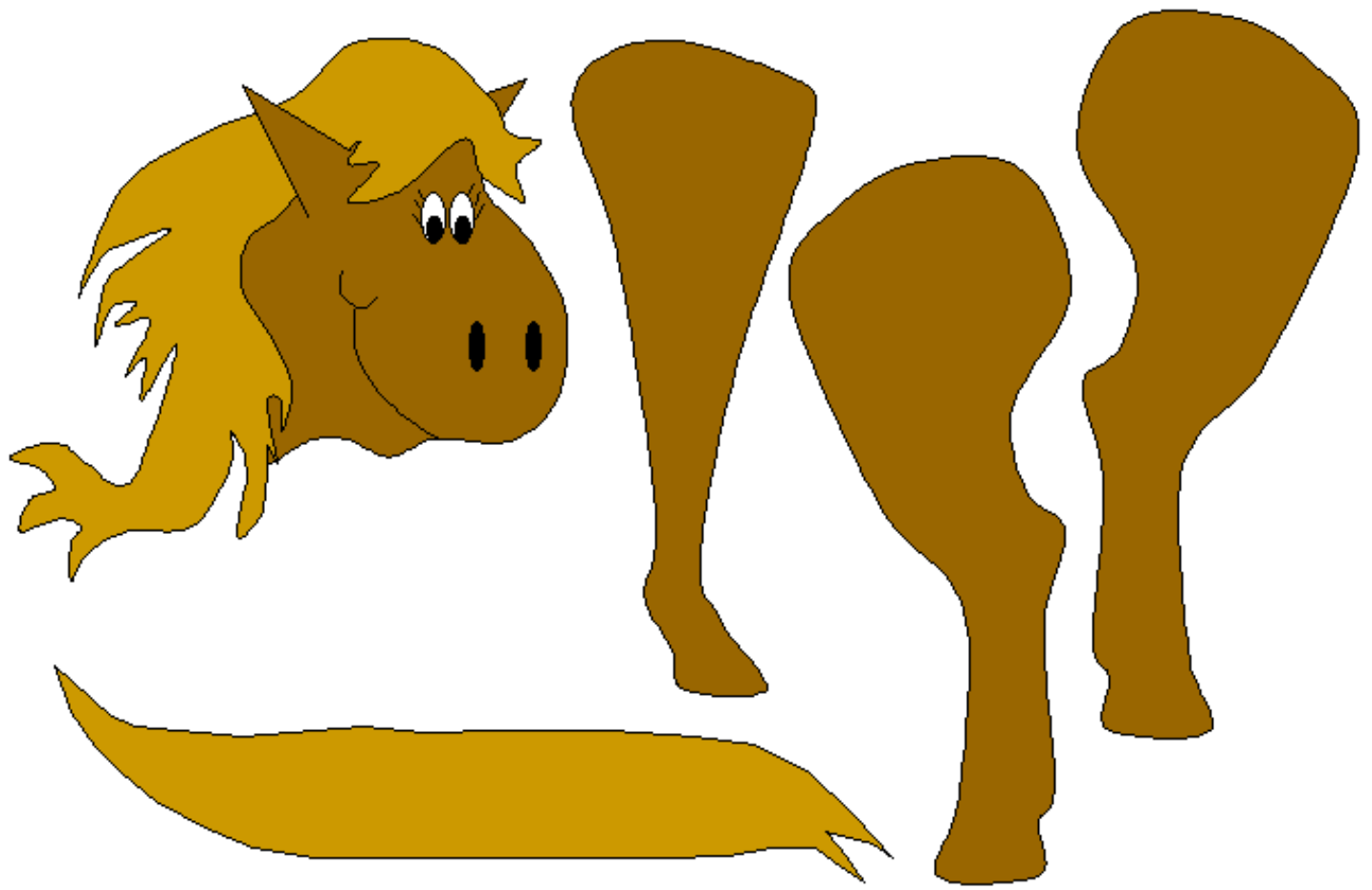
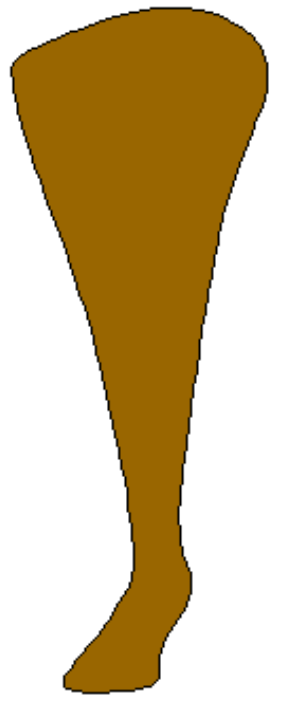

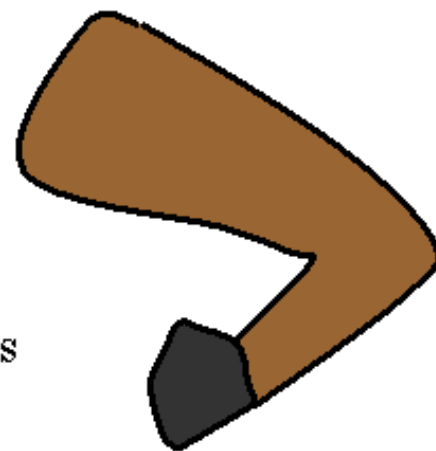
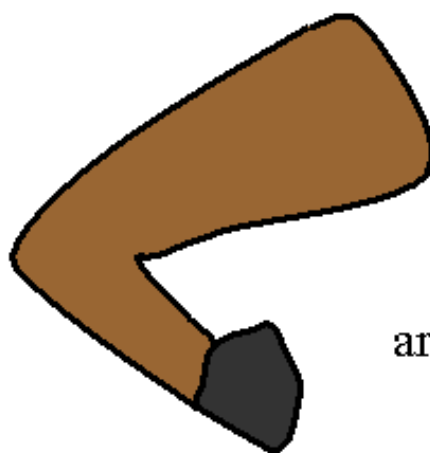
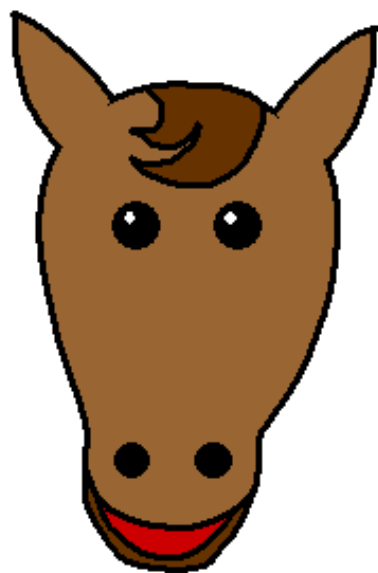


Fold in half and glue together. Fold tab and glue on the back of the top roll, sticking out to give a 3D effect.

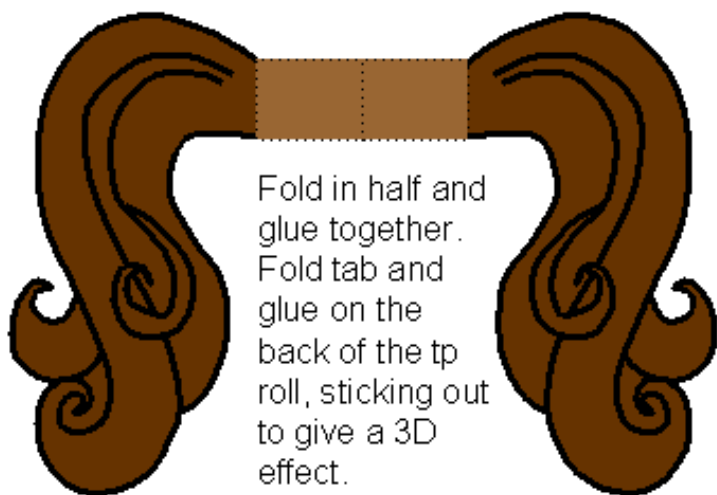


Fold tab and glue to the inside, bottom of the top roll to give the feet a 3D effect.

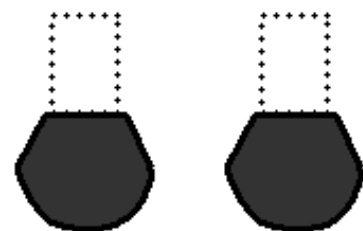
